Instructions for your bathroom vanity

Congratulations on your new solid surface bathroom vanity top! Designed for both beauty and practicality, these monolithic surfaces are perfect for enhancing your space. To maintain their elegance and durability, please follow these care guidelines:

Everyday Cleaning

1. **Routine Maintenance:** For daily care, wipe surfaces with a damp microfiber cloth and a mild soap or household cleaner. This will effectively remove soap scum, toothpaste, and other residues.
2. **Stain Removal:** For tougher stains, use a gentle abrasive cleaner or a mixture of baking soda and water. Apply with a soft sponge in a circular motion, then rinse thoroughly.

Tips to Prevent Damage

1. **Handle Chemical Spills Quickly:** If strong chemicals accidentally spill (like paint strippers or cleaners with harsh solvents), flush the area with plenty of soapy water immediately to avoid damage.
